

7 WAYS TO PREVENT STUBBLE DAMAGE

Protect your investment this harvest season



Inspect Tires Before Harvest

- *Check tread depth, air pressure, lugs and look for cuts or cracks*



Choose Stubble-Resistant Tires

- *Use tires with reinforced sidewalls and protective compounds, such as Stubble Shield*



Install Stubble Stompers

- *Push down stalks ahead of the tire path to reduce punctures*



Maintain Proper Tire Pressure

- *Follow load-based specs or use the Agropressure app to avoid under- or over-inflation*



Inspect Tires Daily During Harvest

- *Look for new cuts/damage and check pressure for hidden leaks*



Walk Fields After Harvest

- *Identify zones with dense or sharp stubble for future planning*



Use Tillage to Break Down Stubble

- *Chop or remove stalks before next seasons to help improve soil and reduce punctures*
