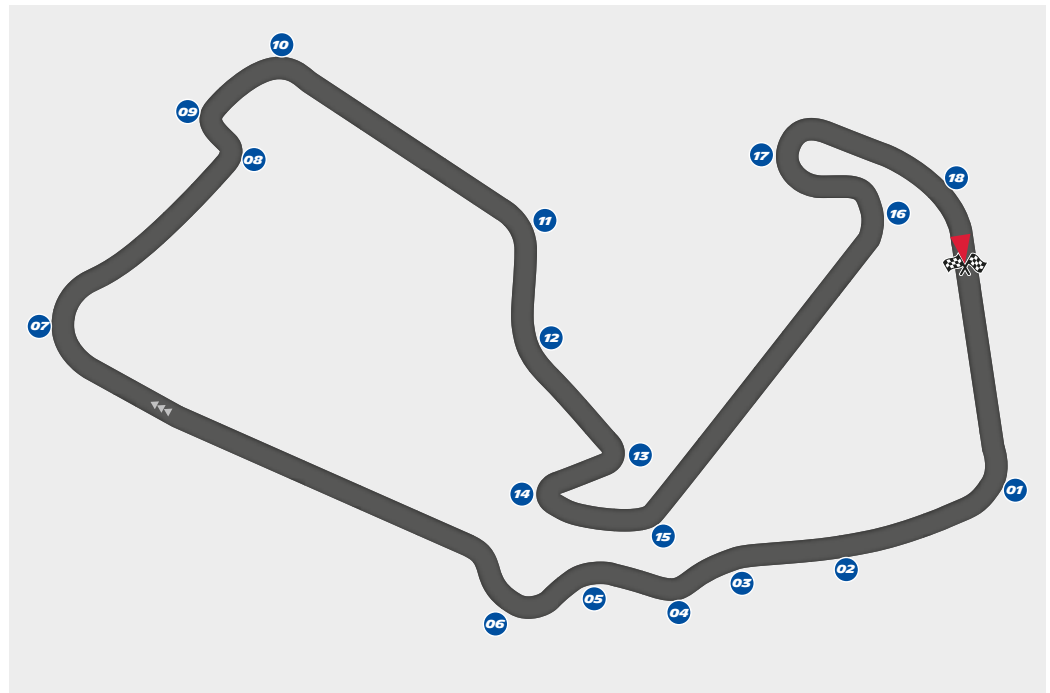

FEATURES

Silverstone is a very fast track that features several high-speed corners which put big constraints on tyre casings. A good aerodynamic set-up is vital. Rain can never be ruled out, even at the height of summer.

"Silverstone was recently resurfaced, so it's pretty much like we were going there for the very first time since we have zero data. Water tends not to drain away, and the new asphalt means wet weather grip is likely to be very low. Due to the characteristics of the new surface, i.e. low macro and high micro roughness, wear rates promise to be low if the conditions stay dry. This is sure to have an impact on the way the tyres perform during the race, especially if the temperature is high."

MICHELIN AND THE 2018 6 HOURS OF SILVERSTONE

- » The 6 Hours of Silverstone is being held in summer for the first time since 2012
- » 30 cars on Michelin tyres
- » 3,200 tyres available
- » LMP1 cars: medium and hard slicks, plus a slick intermediate, a rain tyre and a full wet
- » LMP2 cars: medium and hard slicks, plus an intermediate and a full wet
- » LM GTE cars: medium and hard slicks, plus intermediate/full wets

MICHELIN'S ENDURANCE RACING RECORD AT SILVERSTONE

- » Michelin has won the 6 Hours of Silverstone six times as an FIA WEC round: with Audi (3 times), Toyota (2) and Porsche (1)
- » 10 years ago, Michelin won the 1,000km of Silverstone with Allan McNish/Rinaldo Capello (Audi R10)
- » Michelin has won FIA GT races at Silverstone with McLaren, Chrysler, Porsche, Aston Martin and Saleen
- » Michelin has won with BMW at Silverstone in the Blancpain Endurance Series
- » Fernando Alonso won the 2006 British Grand Prix at Silverstone on Michelin tyres

SILVERSTONE TRIVIA

- » Silverstone Circuit is built on a former Royal Air Force airfield
- » In 1950, Silverstone hosted the very first Formula 1 World Championship race
- » The circuit straddles the counties of Northamptonshire and Buckinghamshire
- » Silverstone hosted a Sportscar World Championship round in 1976
- » Numerous F1 teams are based in Silverstone (Red Bull, Force India, etc.)



4 HOURS OF SILVERSTONE Round 4: 2018 European Le Mans Series

SATURDAY, AUGUST 18, 2018

The same weekend, Silverstone is also hosting Round 4 of the 2018 European Le Mans Series, with Michelin runners in the LM P2 and LM P3 classes.

In LM P2, IDEC Sport/Michelin is currently fourth in the championship, three points off a podium footing.

Michelin is the exclusive tyre supplier in LM P3. RLR MSport provisionally tops the table ahead of EuroInternational.

The 2018 4 Hours of Silverstone starts at 2:30pm local time on Saturday, August 18.

FIA WEC SPORTING REGULATIONS

FIA WEC grid orders for six-hour races are based on the average best qualifying times of each car's two nominated drivers (except at Le Mans)

Starts take the form of rolling starts after a formation lap

To be classified, a car must cross the finish line and complete at least 70 percent of the distance covered by the race winner

POINTS-SCORING SYSTEM (SIX-HOUR RACES)

- 1st, 25 points.
- 2nd, 18 points.
- 3rd, 15 points.
- 4th, 12 points.
- 5th, 10 points.
- 6th, 8 points.
- 7th, 6 points.
- 8th, 4 points.
- 9th, 2 points.
- 10th, 1 point.

Other finishers, 0.5 point
Pole position: bonus point (Drivers and Manufacturers)

Non-hybrid LM P1 and LM P2 cars: 3 types of slick for the season for all the cars / 2 types of slick to be nominated 48 hours before the Prologue test / 2 types of slick for each race (from the above 3) to be nominated 48 hours before the start of scrutineering (3 types of slick for Le Mans)

LM GTE Pro and LM GTE Am: 3 types of slick per model for the season / 2 types of slick to be nominated 48 hours before the Prologue test / 1 additional type of slick can be registered in the course of the season / 2 types of slick for each race (from the above 3) to be nominated 48 hours before the start of scrutineering (3 types of slick for Le Mans)

INTERMEDIATE AND RAIN TYRES

Can only be used if Race Control declares the track to be wet (free practice, qualifying, race). No quotas per race.

FIA WEC TYRE REGULATIONS

LM P2: 1 type of intermediate tyre and 1 type of rain tyre for the season for all cars entered 48 hours before the Prologue. The re-cutting of tread patterns is not authorised.

LM GTE Am: 1 type of intermediate tyre and 1 type of rain tyre per model entered 48 hours before the Prologue. The re-cutting of tread patterns is not authorised.

In the course of the season, a competitor may change tyre brand no more than once.

Penalty: a 3-minute Stop&Go penalty for tyre regulation breaches

A maximum of 4 mechanics and 2 tyre guns for wheel changes during pit stops. Tyre changes may now be carried out while the car is being refuelled.

1 tyre technician is authorised to carry out a visual inspection of the tyres and check their pressures.

Tyre changes are only authorised a) on the grid up to the three-minute board, b) in front of the car's garage during a pit stop or inside the garage in the case of longer work on the car, c) on the track if the race is suspended.

Tyres are identified by RFID chips and bar codes. All tyre serial numbers must be communicated to the Technical Delegates 48 hours in advance.
