






### 10 Power front slicks

- ✓ Up to 5 Power Slick Soft

- ✓ Up to 5 Power Slick Hard







### 12 Power rear slicks

- ✓ Up to 6 Power Slick Soft
- ✓ Up to 5 Power Slick Medium
- ✓ Up to 4 Power Slick Hard







Riders who participate in both O1 and O2:

- ✓ + 1 MICHELIN Front Power Slick (of the specification the riders prefer)
- ✓ 1 MICHELIN Rear Power Slick Soft

In the case that Q1 and Q2 sessions are both declared wet by the Race Director, the extra tyres allocated will be rain tyres. In the case that Q1 and Q2 sessions are declared as different weather conditions (dry or wet) then no extra tyre will be allocated.

In the case that any 4 of the 5 sessions, being FP1, 2, 3, 4, and one Qualifying session (excluding warm-up), are declared wet, one more set of rain tyres will be allocated to every rider, and the allocation automatically becomes: 7 Front rain tyres, and 8 Rear rain tyres.



KNOW WHAT TO EXPECT.

Back-to-back races are always a demanding time, but at these two events ahead of us we also have the added pressure of three

MotoE races over the two weekends as well as the two MotoGP races. It will be a very busy time, but everybody involved will be totally focused on their different roles to make sure all the riders - no matter what class - get exactly the same kind of information and assistance. Misano is an unusual circuit and you never really know what to expect. It gave lots of grip in 2018 and we broke records and saw fast and consistent laps, but then last year the asphalt behaved as if there was hardly any traction at all, so it was good to have it resurfaced in readiness for this season and because of testing we conducted with various teams and riders, we have the data to choose this year's compounds, we now have to see how the asphalt performs during a race weekend.

MotoE will have three **CIRCUIT AND YOU NEVER REALLY** races, one during the first weekend and then two the following week. We will be using the new tyres

> with the biomaterials and regenerated materials, these performed really well at Jerez in July and we expect them to give the riders the grip they need for this form of sustainable racing, which is very important to Michelin. There will also be a big change during these two weekends because we will have spectators for the first time after five races without any. It will be a smaller amount than is normally at Misano, but this is an important step forward, especially when you consider how much Italy suffered at the start of this pandemic, it is a very positive step to see the relevant authorities taking this decision and allowing some fans in, I hope we all give them a show to be proud of.



## RACE **FORMATS**

### PRACTICE

Two practice sessions (30 minutes) on Friday

### E-POLE **QUALIFYING** PRACTICE

Each rider will carry out 3 laps of the circuit (one warm up lap - one timed lap - one slow down lap).

The riders will start one by one, from the end of the pit lane

The starting order of the riders will be the opposite of the combined free practice results

### GRID

Grid positions will be based on the fastest time recorded by the riders in the E-Pole qualifying session.

In the case where the E-Pole qualifying session has been cancelled, the grid position will be based on the fastest times recorded by riders in all free practice sessions.

### RACE

Riders will complete one sighting lap before taking their position on the grid. There is no warm up lap, once the grid preparations have finished, the red light will go out and the race starts.

Tyre warmers may be used on the grid. Charging of the battery on the grid is permitted

# NEW **MICHELIN POWER RANGE**
