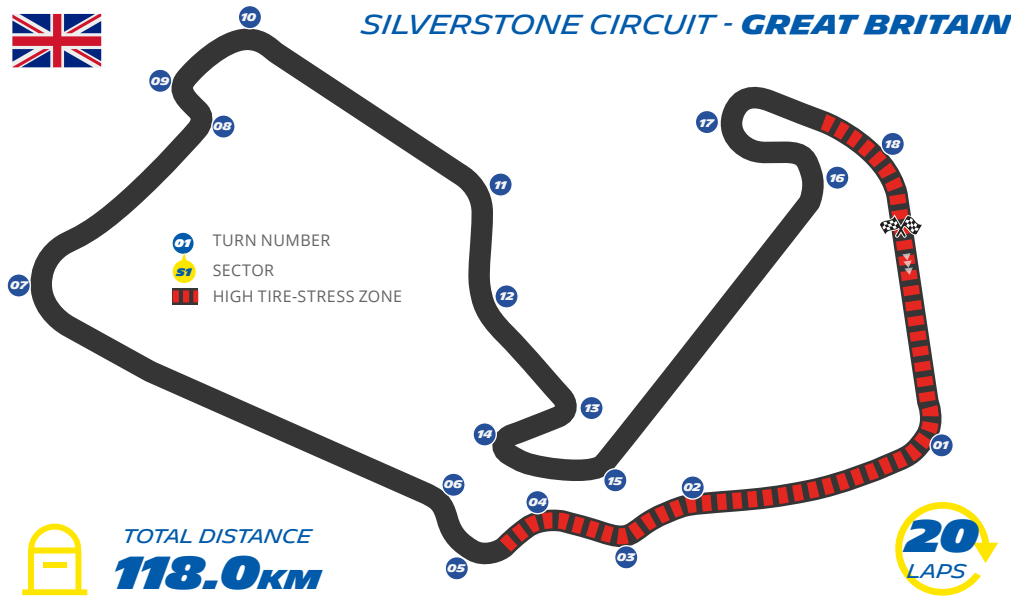

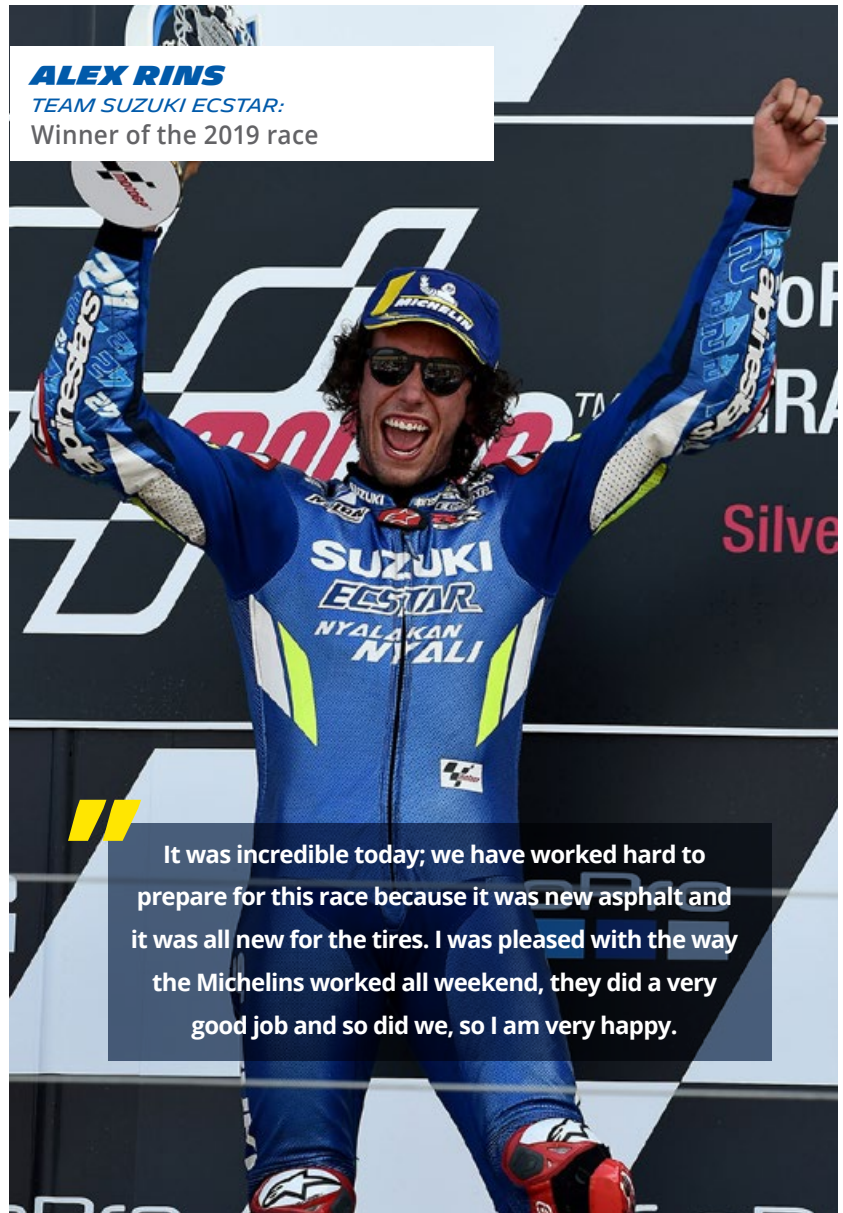

ALLOCATION PER RACE:

MICHELIN POWER "SLICK": 22

10 Power front slicks

- ✓ Up to 5 Power Slick Soft
- ✓ Up to 5 Power Slick Medium
- ✓ Up to 5 Power Slick Hard



12 Power rear slicks

- ✓ Up to 6 Power Slick Soft
- ✓ Up to 5 Power Slick Medium
- ✓ Up to 4 Power Slick Hard



Riders who participate in both Q1 and Q2:

- ✓ + 1 MICHELIN Front Power Slick (of the specification the riders prefer)
- ✓ 1 MICHELIN Rear Power Slick Soft

In the case that Q1 and Q2 sessions are both declared wet by the Race Director, the extra tires allocated will be rain tires.

In the case that Q1 and Q2 sessions are declared as different weather conditions (dry or wet) then no extra tire will be allocated.

In the case that any 4 of the 5 sessions, being FP1, 2, 3, 4, and one Qualifying session (excluding warm-up), are declared wet, one more set of rain tires will be allocated to every rider, and the allocation automatically becomes: 7 Front rain tires, and 8 Rear rain tires.

THIS IS SUCH AN ICONIC CIRCUIT, WITH A GREAT HISTORY

mix of high speeds on the straights and the very fast corners. With this in mind, our designers have worked hard to create tires that can resist the heat generated by the high speeds, and provide the considerable stability, grip and agility needed to handle the fast direction changes demanded by the riders.

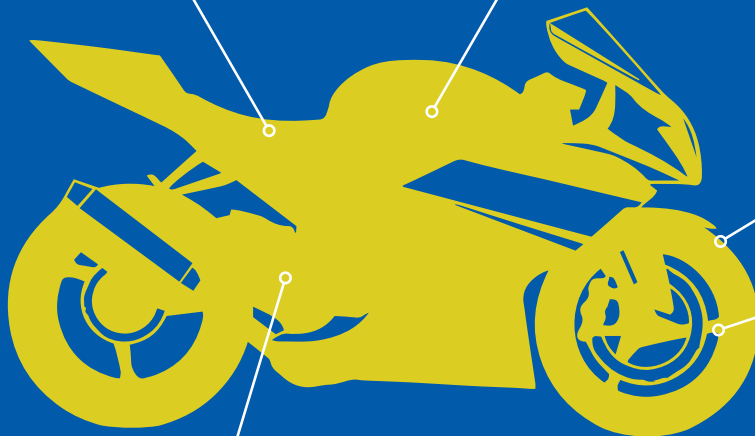
