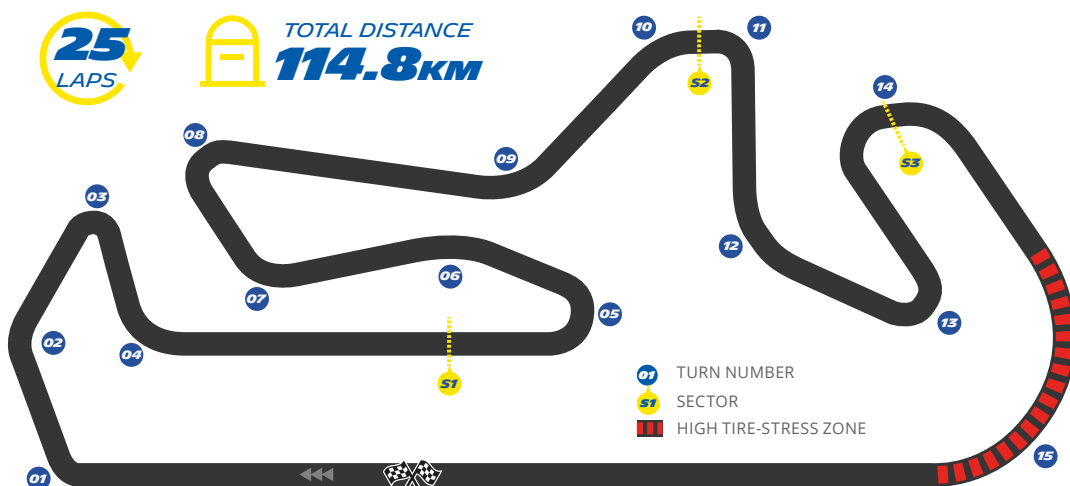

Riders who participate in both Q1 and Q2:

- ✓ + 1 MICHELIN Front Power Slick (of the specification the riders prefer)
- ✓ 1 MICHELIN Rear Power Slick Soft

In the case that Q1 and Q2 sessions are both declared wet by the Race Director, the extra tires allocated will be rain tires.

In the case that Q1 and Q2 sessions are declared as different weather conditions (dry or wet) then no extra tire will be allocated.

In the case that any 4 of the 5 sessions, being FP1, 2, 3, 4, and one Qualifying session (excluding warm-up), are declared wet, one more set of rain tires will be allocated to every rider, and the allocation automatically becomes:
7 Front rain tires, and 8 Rear rain tires.

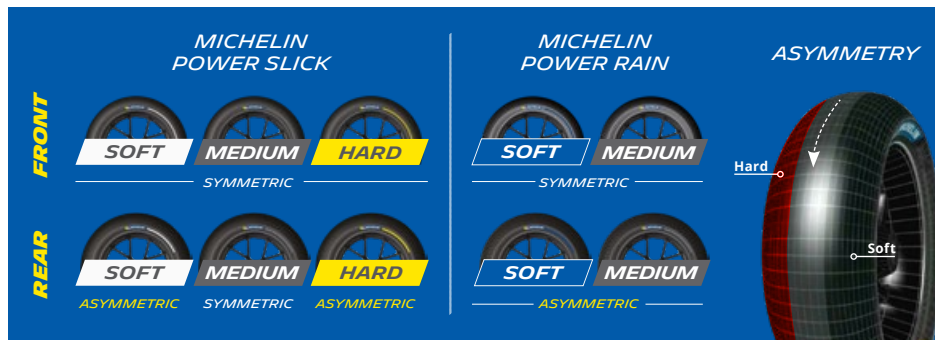

Following our record-breaking race weekend in Austin, and the logistically challenging start to the 2022 season, we are looking forward to our return to Europe. As this is now the fourth visit to Portimão for MotoGP™ we have more detailed track data which has helped us to further fine-

tune our tire allocation for this weekend. The opening four races were a real roller-coaster in terms of exciting racing for the fans, and I'm confident this high level will continue now we are at this incredible Algarve circuit, with its own high speed roller-coaster.

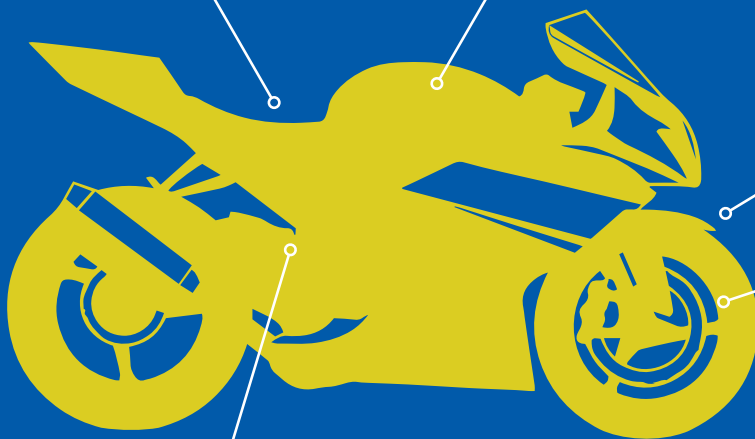

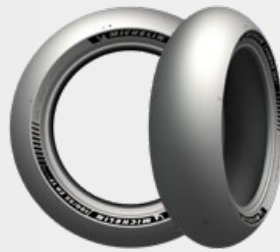
