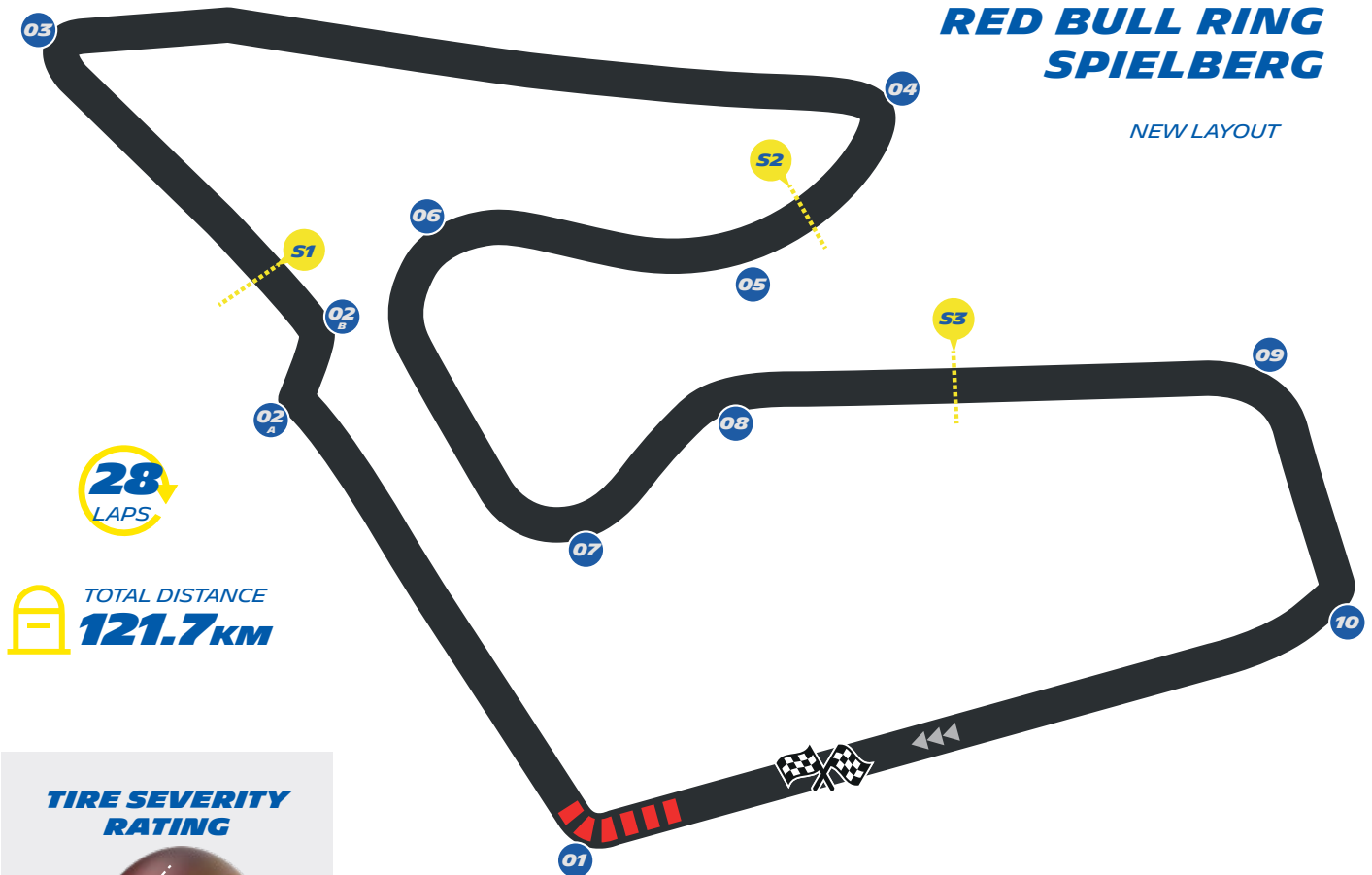

Depending on weather conditions, this could be a tough race due to the very particular layout at the Red Bull Ring. However,

we need to see what effect the new chicane at Turn 2 will have on the tires, as previously the first half of the lap allowed the riders to maintain very high speeds. But as is always the case in racing, the proof of the pudding will be in the eating!

As last year, the very specific

construction of the rear tire casings for this circuit are designed to cope with its one-of-a-kind layout, and to resist the heat that

will be generated during the race. As a complement to the casing construction, the tread rubber compounds have been designed to offer the riders consistent grip and predictable handling throughout the weekend, from the Free Practice and Qualifying sessions, through to the 28-lap race.

## WHAT ARE SUSTAINABLE MATERIALS?

Michelin considers sustainable materials to be those that are **recycled materials**, or **bio-sourced materials** that are renewable over the scale of a human lifetime, and which do not come into competition with the food industry. Examples:



**Recycled materials:** styrene regenerated from waste polystyrene (yoghurt pots, food trays, packaging, etc.), textiles regenerated from PET\* waste (plastic bottles, dispensers, etc.), carbon black recycled from end-of-life tires.

**Renewable bio-sourced materials:** natural rubber from a responsible industry, butadiene (or bio-butadiene), products made from biomass (plant waste).

## NEW RACE FORMAT

### FREE PRACTICE

Two practice sessions (20 minutes) on Friday

### QUALIFYING PRACTICE

E-pole is replaced by more traditional Qualifying sessions:

Q1: the slowest 10 riders from the combined results of FP1 and FP2.

Q2: the fastest 8 riders from the combined results of FP1 and FP2 plus the fastest 2 riders from Q1.

### RACE

Riders will complete one sighting lap before taking their position on the grid. There is no warm up lap, once the grid preparations have finished, the red light will go out and the race starts.

Tire warmers may be used on the grid.

Charging of the battery on the grid is permitted.

### POINTS-SCORING SYSTEM
