In the case that Q1 and Q2 sessions are declared as different weather conditions (dry or wet) then no extra tire will be allocated.

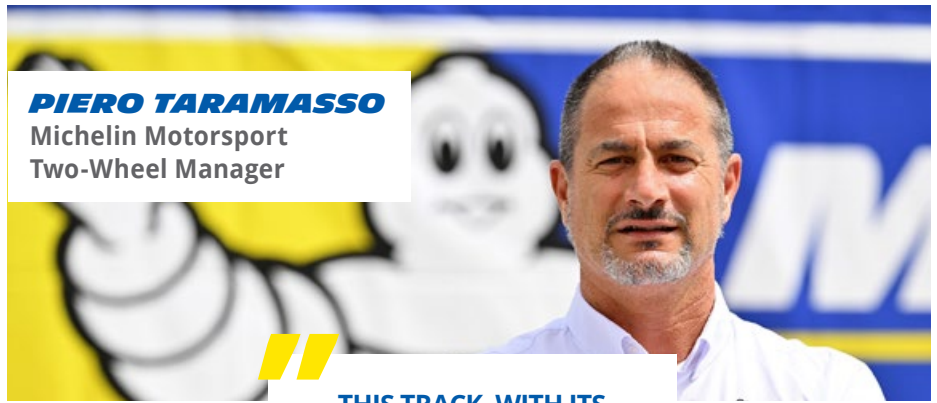

In the case that any 4 of the 5 sessions, being FP1, 2, 3, 4, and one Qualifying session (excluding warm-up), are declared wet, one more set of rain tires will be allocated to every rider, and the allocation automatically becomes:
7 Front rain tires, and 8 Rear rain tires.

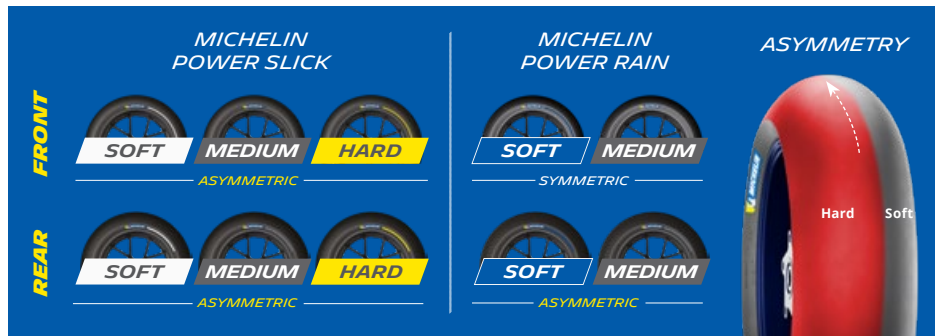
THIS TRACK, WITH ITS PARTICULAR LAYOUT AND ASPHALT, ALWAYS PUTS OUR TIRES UNDER CLOSE SCRUTINY

The last time we raced here was in 2019, and at that time we tested our new rear slick construction, which is the one we now have

in our 2022 allocation. This track, with its particular layout and asphalt, always puts our tires under close scrutiny because they need to offer the grip, durability, consistency and performance that this circuit demands. Our unique selection of 'Phillip Island' compound tires don't only have to meet these

criteria, but they also have to do this in the mixed weather conditions that can prevail here close to the sea.

Even though this is our first visit here with our latest rear tire construction, these tyres have proved their pace and durability at other circuits on the MotoGP calendar, so I have no doubt that they will allow the riders to push as always and give the passionate fans an exciting race weekend to remember.

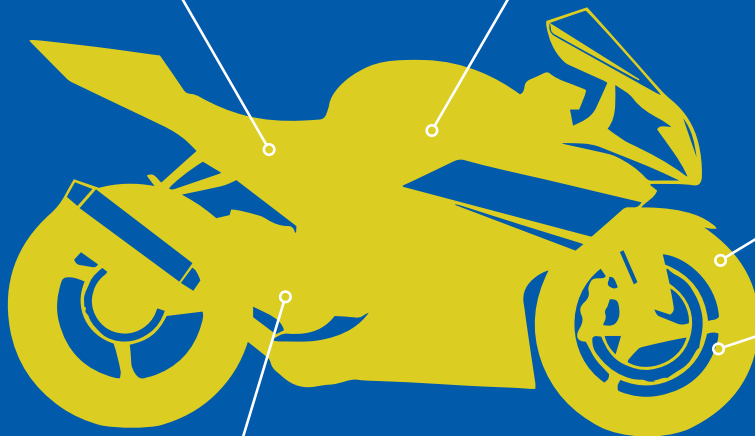

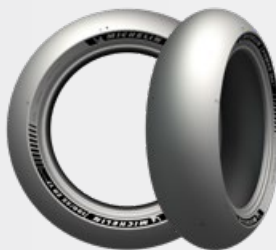
