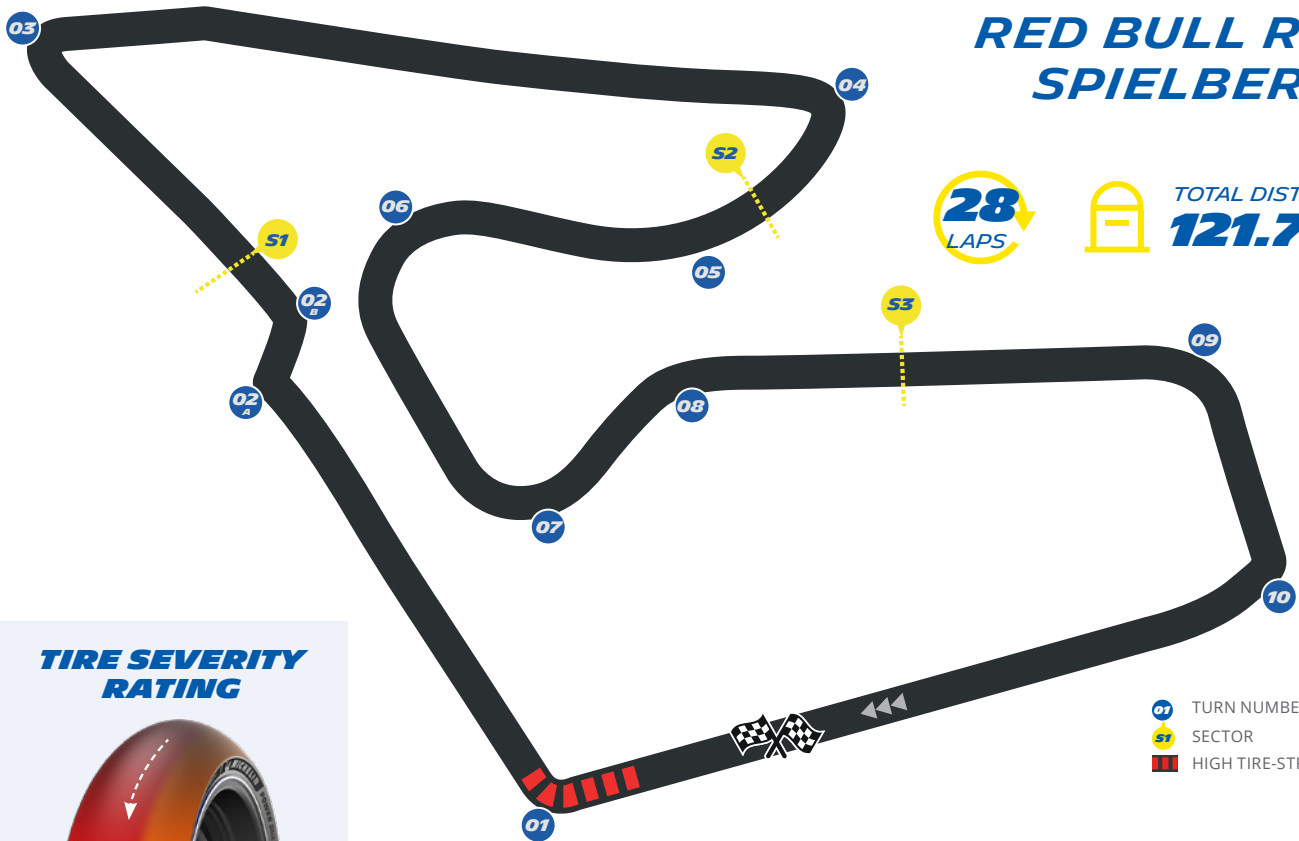

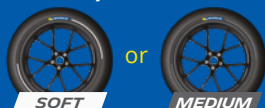

## TIRES WITH A HIGHER RESISTANCE CASING FOR THE REAR, AND A REINFORCED RUBBER COMPOUND ON THE RIGHT SIDE

It's an atypical circuit, with specific tires. The Red Bull Ring presents particular challenges which are likely to place unusual demands on our tires. Here, the three straights generate significant longitudinal forces when accelerating and braking, and this combined with the corners, especially the right-handers, creates thermal challenges that we must anticipate. For this reason we have chosen to manufacture tires with a higher resistance casing for the rear, and to equip them with a reinforced rubber compound on the right side - to cope with the greater number of

turns in this direction. Nothing changes, however, regarding the range of available compounds. At the front, the three compounds -Soft, Medium and Hard- will be symmetrical, while the Soft and Medium rears will be asymmetrical. If rain was to make an appearance, which cannot be ruled out, our MICHELIN Power Rain tires will of course be available to the riders. With this tire allocation, we will enable our partners to engage in battle without performance limits, and in complete safety, whatever the conditions.

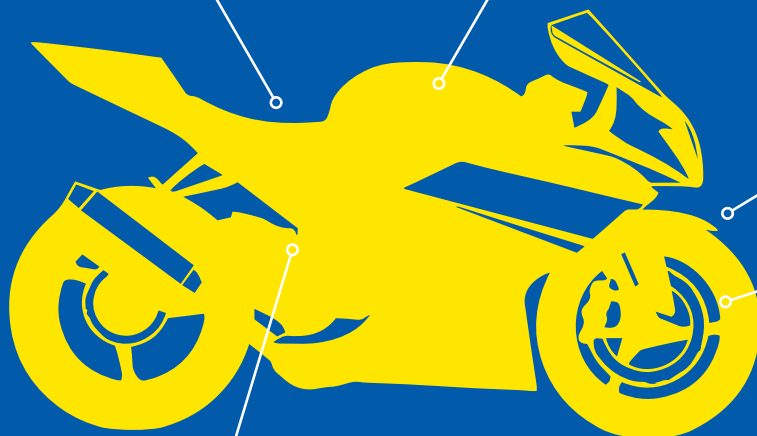

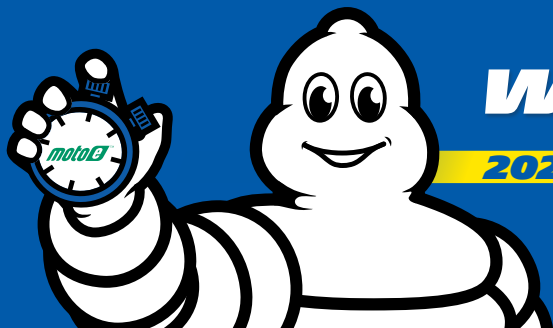

## MICHELIN POWER TIRES FOR THE 2023 CHAMPIONSHIP

For 2023, Michelin has developed a new front and new rear tire that now incorporate 34 and 52 percent sustainable raw materials respectively. These two tires take their inspiration from the brand's MotoGP™ range and are designed to match the characteristics of the new all-electric Ducati bikes that will feature in this year's series.

### SUSTAINABLE MATERIALS

To make its MotoE™ tires, Michelin employs an extensive palette of biosourced and recycled sustainable raw materials, including:

- ✓ Hevea latex (natural rubber)
- ✓ Used truck and car tires (Enviro rCB)
- ✓ Orange and lemon peel (limonene resin)
- ✓ Pine-tree resin
- ✓ Sunflower oil
- ✓ Recycled scrap steel

**Aim:** Reducing the impact on the planet's resources while meeting the safety and performance requirements of competition tires.

## ALLOCATION

### A single front rear pairing

- ✓ **Exceptional versatility:** just one combination of front and rear tires to cover all the circuits visited by the 2023 series.
- ✓ **High performance:** a revised materials-specification, yet superior performance compared with 2022
- ✓ **Grip:** grip performance from Turn 1, Lap

- Riders who participate in both QP1 and QP2 qualifying sessions (maximum 2 riders) will be allocated one extra rear slick tire after QP2 (therefore, if taken, a maximum of 5 rear new slick tires).
- In the case that QP1 and QP2 sessions are both declared wet by the Race Director, the extra tires allocated will be rain tires.
- In the case that QP1 and QP2 sessions are declared as different weather conditions then no extra tire will be allocated.
