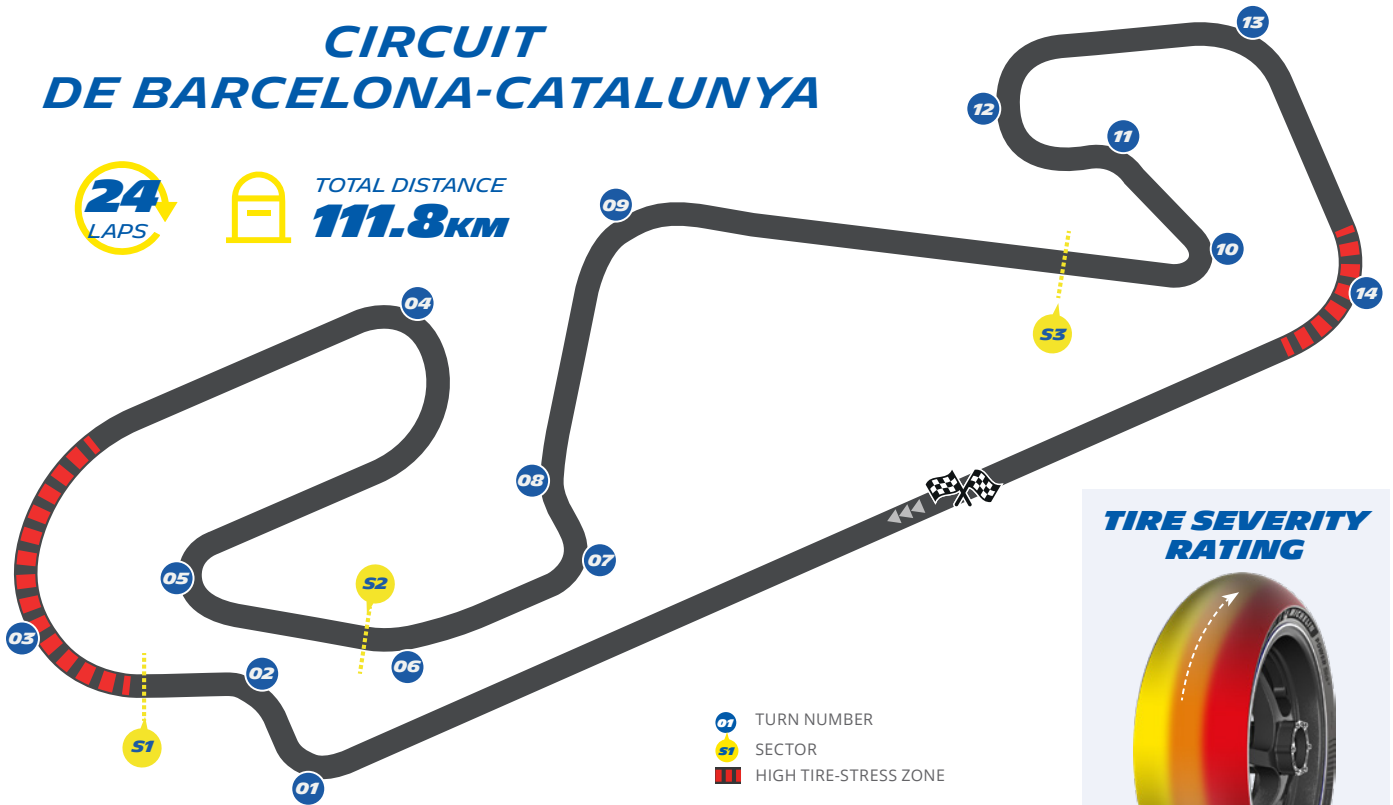

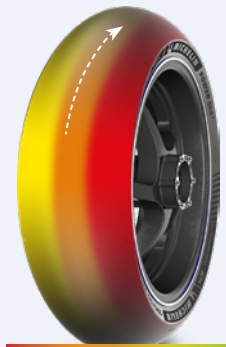

WE WILL BRING THE HARDEST COMPOUND OF THE SEASON FOR THE FRONT TYRE TO THE BARCELONA-CATALUNYA CIRCUIT

We will bring the hardest compound of the season for the front tyre to the Barcelona-Catalunya circuit. The asphalt here was redone in 2018, and as a result the grip levels are very

low, however the high temperatures and the circuit layout mean that this is still a very demanding track. We have chosen to deal with this severity by supplying

symmetrical tires with three compounds for the front, and two for the rear. The high speed nature of the circuit led us to select asymmetric rear tires, with reinforced rubber on the right

side. With this allocation we will be able to respond to all situations, as we did in 2022 when we brought a similar range of MICHELIN Power Slick tires.



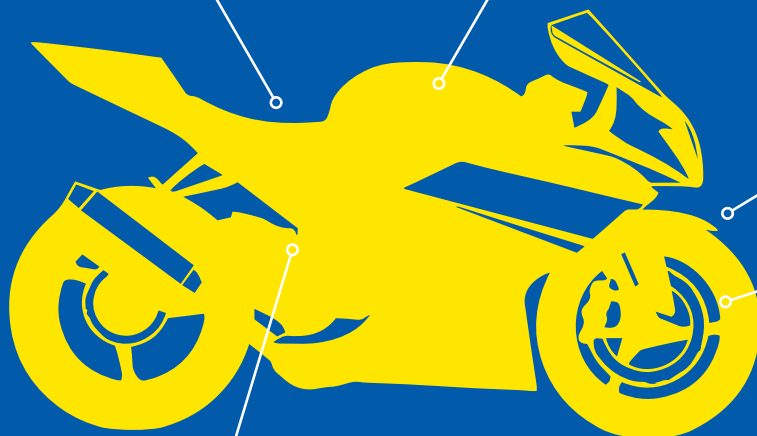

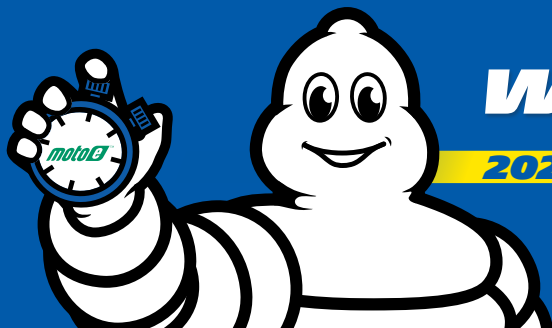

MICHELIN POWER TIRES FOR THE 2023 CHAMPIONSHIP

For 2023, Michelin has developed a new front and new rear tire that now incorporate 34 and 52 percent sustainable raw materials respectively. These two tires take their inspiration from the brand's MotoGP™ range and are designed to match the characteristics of the new all-electric Ducati bikes that will feature in this year's series.

SUSTAINABLE MATERIALS

To make its MotoE™ tires, Michelin employs an extensive palette of biosourced and recycled sustainable raw materials, including:

- ✓ Hevea latex (natural rubber)
- ✓ Used truck and car tires (Enviro rCB)
- ✓ Orange and lemon peel (limonene resin)
- ✓ Pine-tree resin
- ✓ Sunflower oil
- ✓ Recycled scrap steel

Aim: Reducing the impact on the planet's resources while meeting the safety and performance requirements of competition tires.

- In the case that QP1 and QP2 sessions are both declared wet by the Race Director, the extra tires allocated will be rain tires.
- In the case that QP1 and QP2 sessions are declared as different weather conditions then no extra tire will be allocated.

FREE PRACTICE

Two practice sessions (15 minutes) on Friday.

QUALIFYING PRACTICE

Q1: the slowest 10 riders from the combined results of FP1 and FP2.

Q2: the fastest 8 riders from the combined results of FP1 and FP2 plus the fastest 2 riders from Q1.

RACE

Riders will complete one sighting lap before taking their position on the grid. There is no warm up lap, once the grid preparations have finished, the red light will go out and the race starts. Tire warmers may be used on the grid. Charging of the battery on the grid is permitted.
