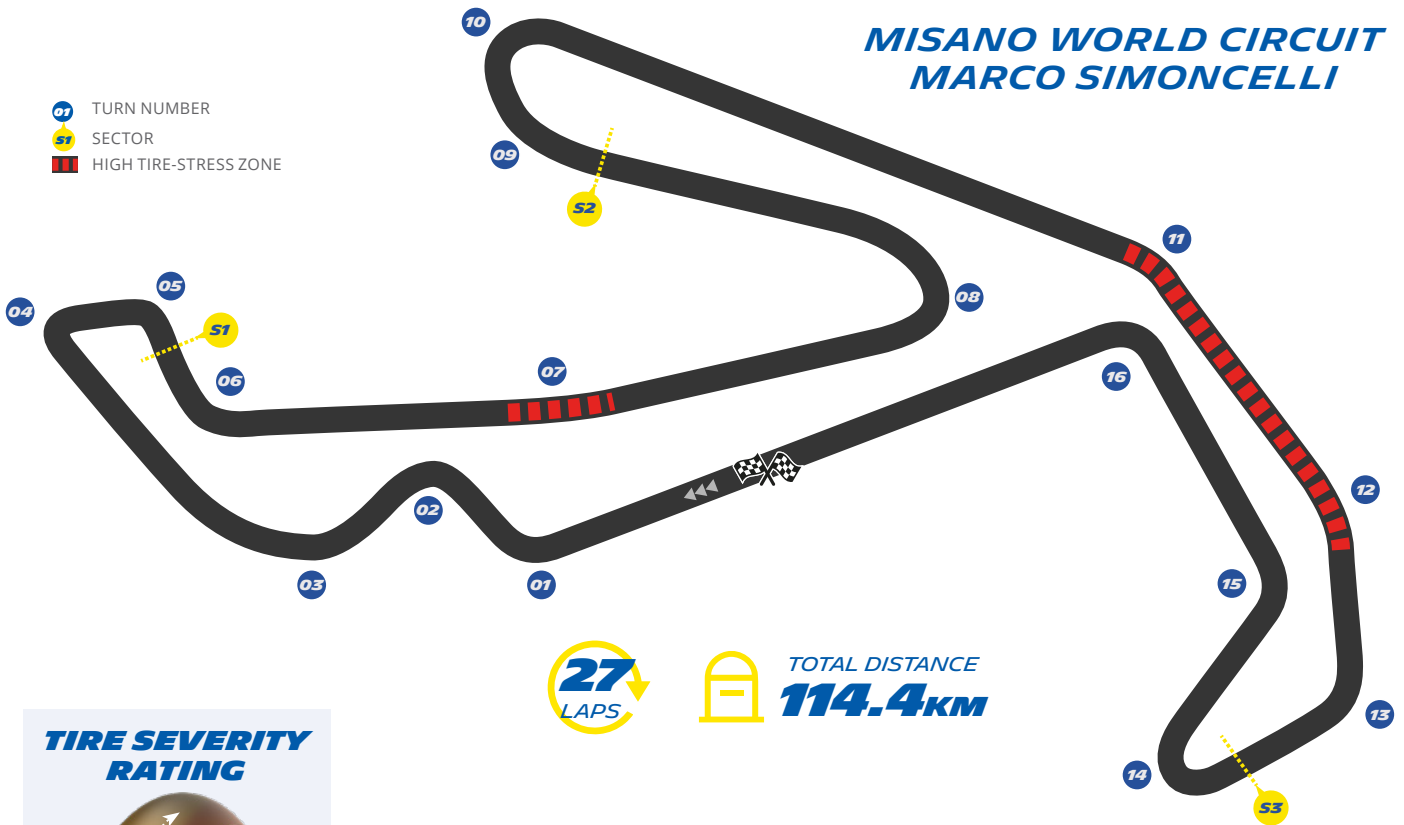

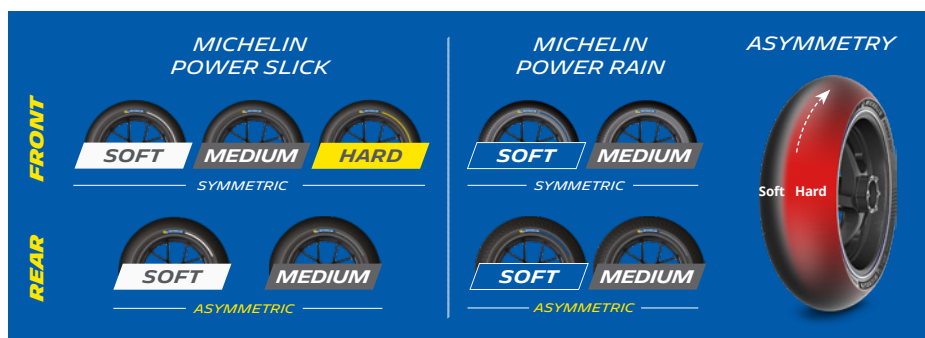

THE CIRCUIT IS QUITE DEMANDING ON THE FRONT TIRES

We all know Misano well because we visit the circuit with our partners not only in races but also in tests. The circuit is flat, rather technical, and alternates between slow turns and fast curves. It is quite demanding on the front tires, particularly from the Curva Tramonto, which is a long hairpin leading on to a high speed straight, to Curvone. This section generates a lot of stress on the tires because it is very fast. We are

expecting rather warm weather, as always here in September, but our MICHELIN

Power Slick ranges are adapted to these seasonal temperatures. Of course, as we are close to the Adriatic Sea the weather can change and rain can make an appearance. In this case, we will offer our MICHELIN Power Rain range, which demonstrate great versatility and excellent grip on wet surfaces.

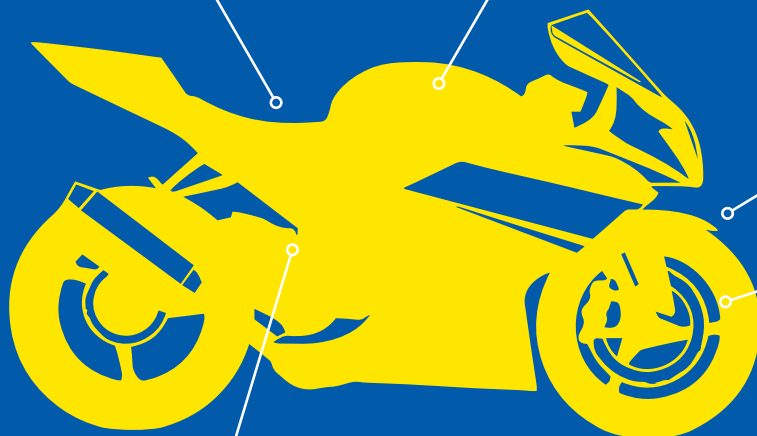

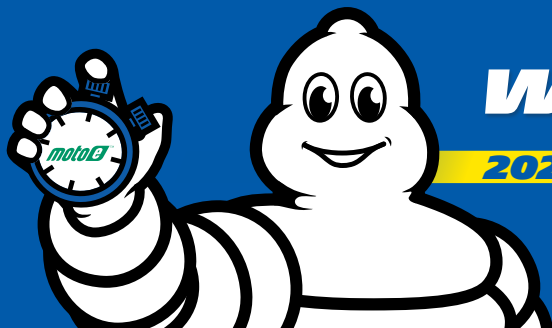

MICHELIN POWER TIRES FOR THE 2023 CHAMPIONSHIP

For 2023, Michelin has developed a new front and new rear tire that now incorporate 34 and 52 percent sustainable raw materials respectively. These two tires take their inspiration from the brand's MotoGP™ range and are designed to match the characteristics of the new all-electric Ducati bikes that will feature in this year's series.

SUSTAINABLE MATERIALS

To make its MotoE™ tires, Michelin employs an extensive palette of biosourced and recycled sustainable raw materials, including:

- ✓ Hevea latex (natural rubber)
- ✓ Used truck and car tires (Enviro rCB)
- ✓ Orange and lemon peel (limonene resin)
- ✓ Pine-tree resin
- ✓ Sunflower oil
- ✓ Recycled scrap steel

Aim: Reducing the impact on the planet's resources while meeting the safety and performance requirements of competition tires.

- Riders who participate in both QP1 and QP2 qualifying sessions (maximum 2 riders) will be allocated one extra rear slick tire after QP2 (therefore, if taken, a maximum of 5 rear new slick tires).
- In the case that QP1 and QP2 sessions are both declared wet by the Race Director, the extra tires allocated will be rain tires.
- In the case that QP1 and QP2 sessions are declared as different weather conditions then no extra tire will be allocated.

It's true that with these electric Ducatis the series has reached a milestone. We have been privileged witnesses to the progress made in terms of performance, with tires specially adapted to these motorcycles which deliver 100% of their torque and almost all their power from the first twist of the throttle. This requires tires capable not only of providing grip when cornering, but also of withstanding significant longitudinal forces during acceleration and braking. This 2023 season has been very competitive and I have no doubt that its finale, with the title at stake, will be just as intense.
