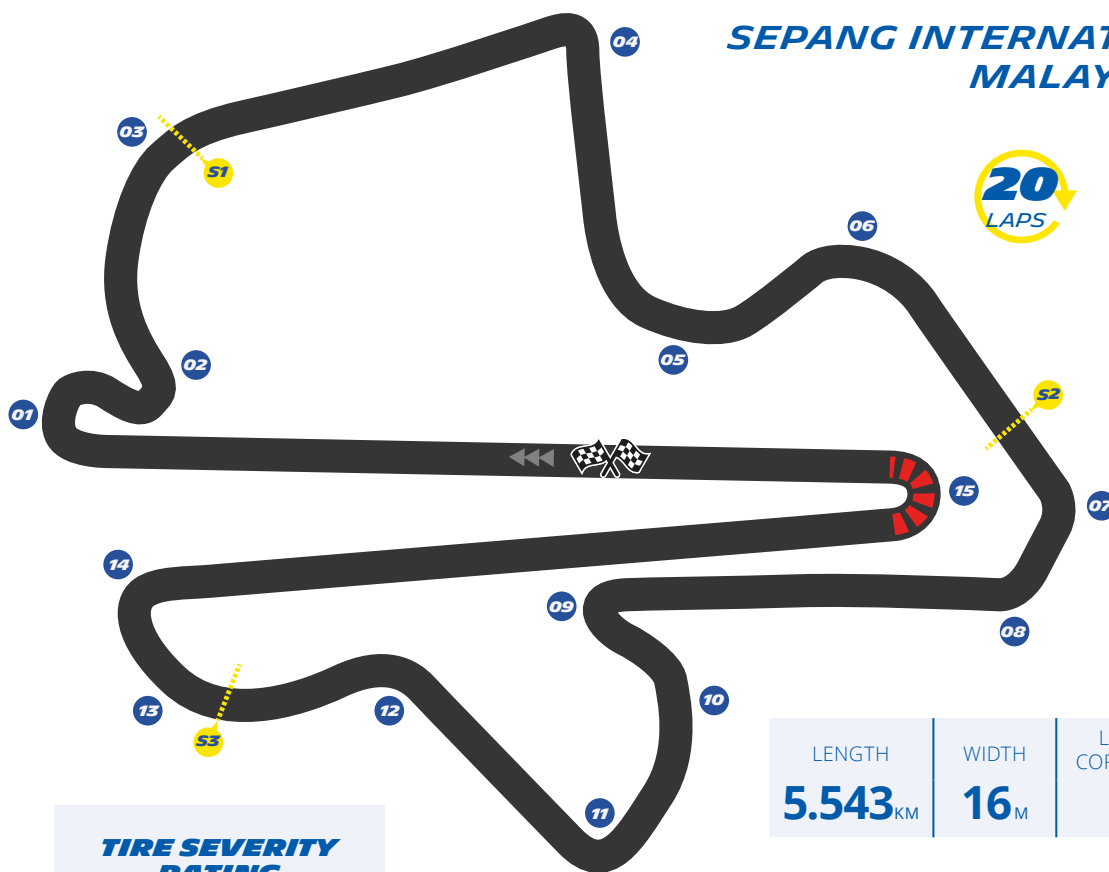

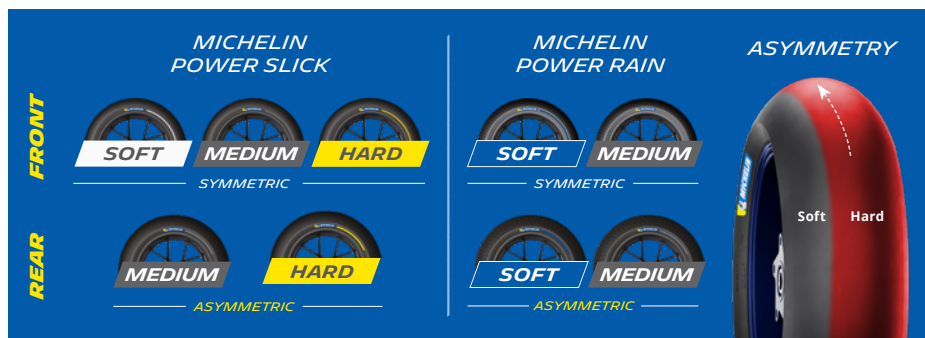

Even if we know the place very well, attention is still required. Sepang is a very complex circuit, where the grip level is good but where humidity always plays an important role. Furthermore, in Asia we are never safe from a storm or torrential rain, and we must be ready to adapt. To meet the requirements of the track, with its mix of slow and fast turns, we will, as always, have a symmetrical front tires available in three compounds (Soft, Medium and Hard). For the rear we have selected two

compounds, Medium and Hard, which will be reinforced on the right side to take into account the greater number of turns in this direction. In the event of rain, our MICHELIN Power Rain range will also be available, in Soft and Medium, with the rear also having a reinforced right side. We will therefore be able to respond to all conditions, and we will stand alongside our partners to support them as best we can throughout this race weekend.



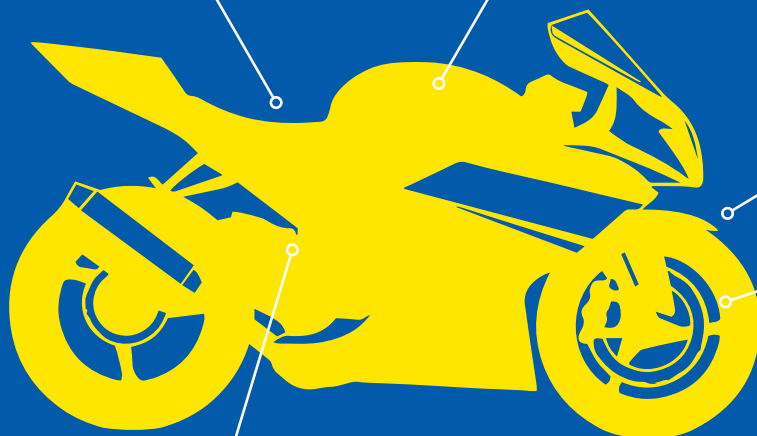
