

Like Jerez, the Bugatti Circuit places medium-intensity stress on the tires. Its layout is technical and the surface offers a good level of grip. One of the main challenges at Le Mans concerns the weather, in particular due to the significant temperature variations in spring, when the morning can be cool and the air temperature does not exceed 10°C. However, in the afternoon, if the sun is shining, the track surface can see temperatures between 30°C and 40°C. The range of temperatures to be covered is therefore wide, and this adaptability can be found in an allocation of tires with specific characteristics. Overall, the centering of the range leans towards Soft or Medium/Soft compared to other circuits. We have just experienced two spectacular races, in Austin and Jerez, during which several riders of different motorcycle brands distinguished themselves, and Le Mans will surely once again be the scene of some great sporting fights, as our team is particularly focused for our national Grand Prix.

Not only have the unique opportunities for innovation that MotoE™ offers seen Michelin increase the proportion of renewable and recycled raw materials that its tyres for the championship contain, but they are also speeding up the emergence of specific solutions for tomorrow's electric motorcycles and scooters.*

**Michelin sees MotoE™ as a means to accelerate innovation as it prepares for tomorrow's world of two-wheel mobility, with powerful analysis and smart data at the heart of its development processes.**

## ***A NEW DESIGN FOR THE REAR TIRE***

This unique design features a head-turning look. Inspired by Michelin's VISION Concept, its ephemeral, velvet-effect Race to Vision motif vanishes once racing begins. VISION is the fruit of the sustainable development model conceived to contribute to Michelin's plan for 2050 and beyond.

- In the case that Q1 and Q2 sessions are both declared wet by the Race Director, the extra tires allocated will be rain tires.
- In the case that Q1 and Q2 sessions are declared as different weather conditions then no extra tire will be allocated.

Two practice sessions (15 minutes) on Friday.

### QUALIFYING PRACTICE

Q1: the slowest 10 riders from the combined results of FP1 and FP2.

Q2: the fastest 8 riders from the combined results of FP1 and FP2 plus the fastest 2 riders from Q1.

### RACE

Riders will complete one sighting lap before taking their position on the grid. There is no warm up lap, once the grid preparations have finished, the red light will go out and the race starts. Tire warmers may be used on the grid. Charging of the battery on the grid is permitted.
