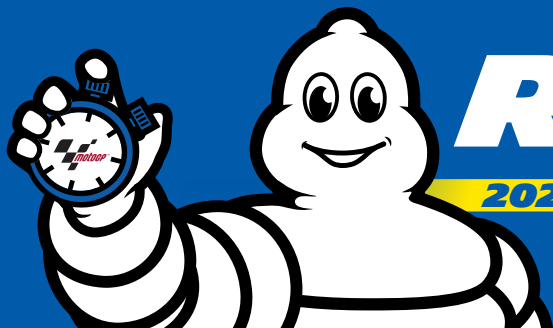

IT'S A VERY DIFFICULT TRACK FOR THE TIRES

Mugello is the most technical circuit of the season. It's a very difficult track for the tires because it mixes slow corners with high-speed curves and very hard braking. This configuration creates very strong constraints in certain sectors, while the very long straight allows the riders to exceed 360 km/h, and this means having tires that are comfortable in all areas of the game. We also know that the weather can be changeable, even at this time of year, but we have everything planned. The location of the circuit in the Tuscan countryside will surely result in fairly cool temperatures at the start of the day, whereas on the other hand, if the sun is shining, it will be very hot in the afternoon. Last year, we recorded 44°C on the ground during the sprint race, and 42°C for the Grand Prix. We have therefore selected rubber compounds accordingly, to compensate for all situations and offer riders tires that are very versatile and consistent in their performance.

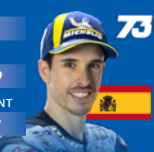

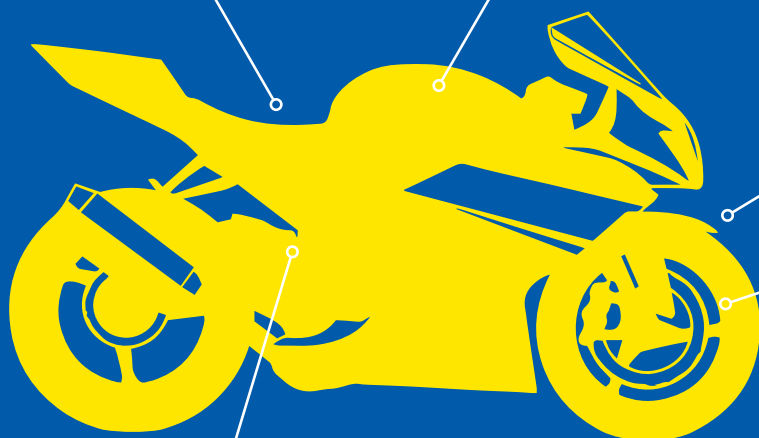

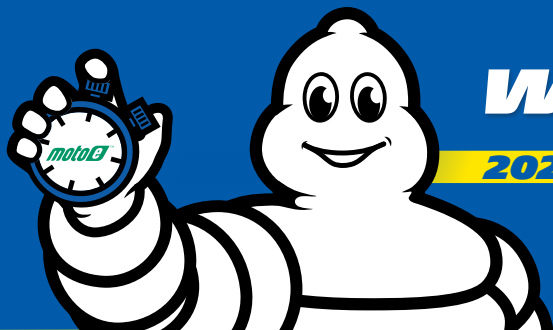

2023 FIM ENEL MotoE™



Michelin has been the FIM MotoE™ World Championship's sole tyre supplier since the all-electric competition was first organised in 2019. The Group sees this highly competitive series as a full-scale research and development laboratory where it can explore and test technological innovations in exacting conditions. Not only have the unique opportunities for innovation that MotoE™ offers seen Michelin increase the proportion of renewable and recycled raw materials that its tyres for the championship contain, but they are also speeding up the emergence of specific solutions for tomorrow's electric motorcycles and scooters.

Michelin sees MotoE™ as a means to accelerate innovation as it prepares for tomorrow's world of two-wheel mobility, with powerful analysis and smart data at the heart of its development processes.

A NEW DESIGN FOR THE REAR TIRE

This unique design features a head-turning look. Inspired by Michelin's VISION Concept, its ephemeral, velvet-effect Race to Vision motif vanishes once racing begins. VISION is the fruit of the sustainable development model conceived to contribute to Michelin's plan for 2050 and beyond.

RENEWABLE AND RECYCLED RAW MATERIALS



The MICHELIN MotoE range of tires contains 49 and 53 percent renewable and recycled materials front and rear respectively, compared with 34 and 52 percent in 2023.

- In the case that Q1 and Q2 sessions are both declared wet by the Race Director, the extra tires allocated will be rain tires.
- In the case that Q1 and Q2 sessions are declared as different weather conditions then no extra tire will be allocated.

QUALIFYING PRACTICE

Q1: the slowest 10 riders from the combined results of FP1 and FP2.

Q2: the fastest 8 riders from the combined results of FP1 and FP2 plus the fastest 2 riders from Q1.

RACE

Riders will complete one sighting lap before taking their position on the grid. There is no warm up lap, once the grid preparations have finished, the red light will go out and the race starts. Tire warmers may be used on the grid. Charging of the battery on the grid is permitted.
