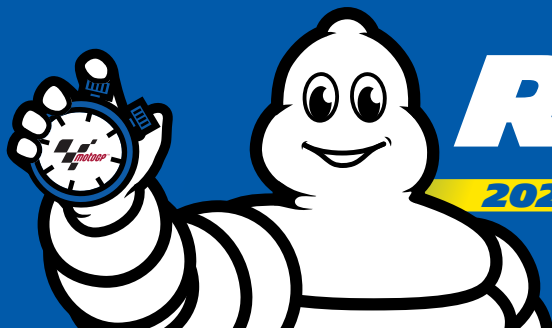

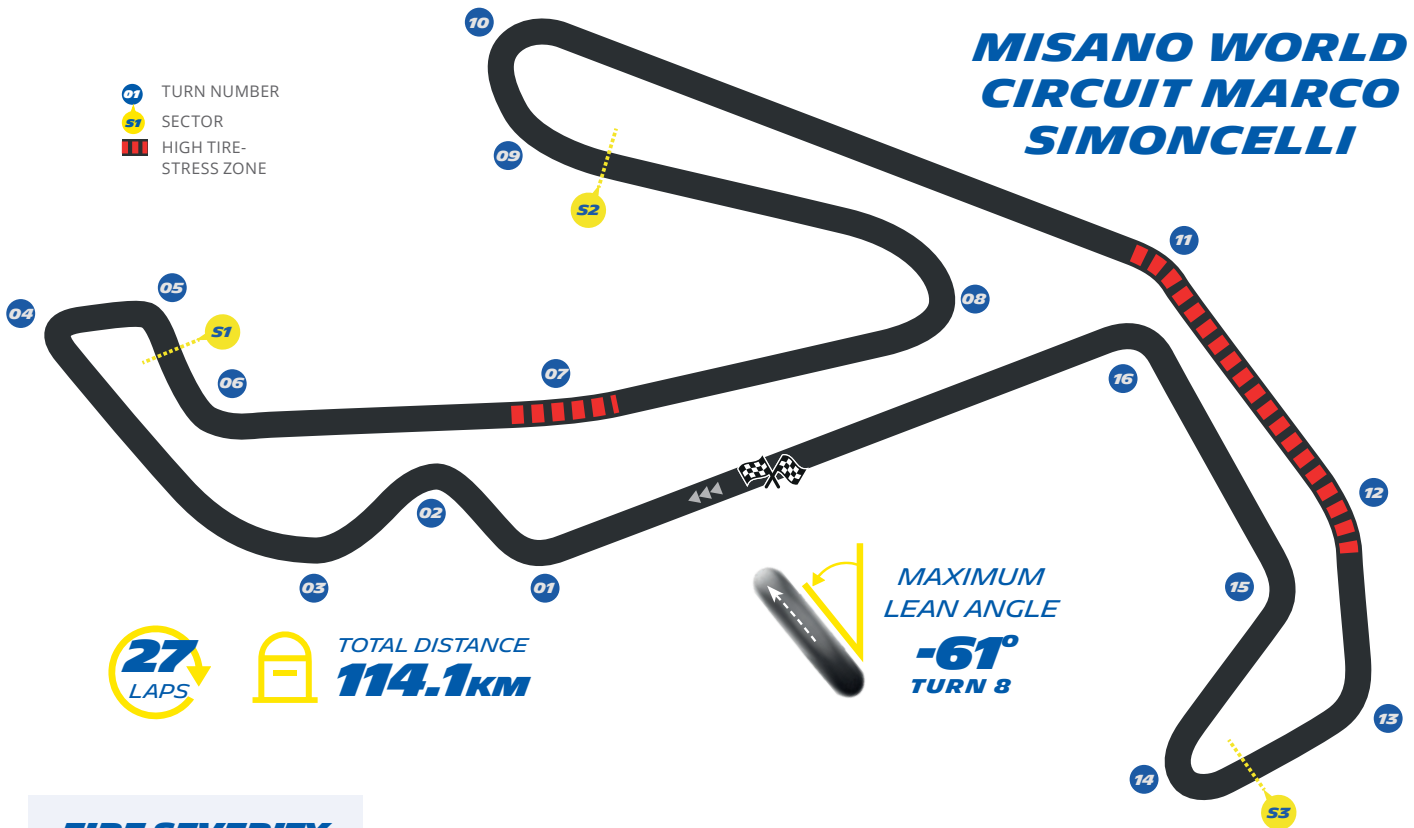

THE DATA CONVINCED US TO SELECT HARDER RUBBER COMPOUNDS FOR THE FRONT

We had been thinking about making these changes since last year, and the data recorded since the start of the 2024 season convinced us to take the plunge and select harder rubber compounds for the front. The tires we brought here last season were perfectly adapted, and we broke all the records. However, given the level of performance of the 2024 bikes and the number of times that they have recently been improved, we realise that our partners now have slightly different tire needs, especially at the front. That's why we made this decision, in order to offer riders even more consistent performance, as well as better feel. Misano is a fairly flat, rather technical track, which is demanding on the tires because it alternates between slow and fast corners. Some sectors, such as the hairpin at Tramonto, or Curvone which is a long very high speed right-hander, generate significant stress on the tires. We know that the combination of harder rubber compounds at the front, along with a rear tire compound that perfectly transmits the power to the track, will create the optimum tire cocktail to perform well.

2023 FIM ENEL MotoE™



Michelin has been the FIM MotoE™ World Championship's sole tyre supplier since the all-electric competition was first organised in 2019. The Group sees this highly competitive series as a full-scale research and development laboratory where it can explore and test technological innovations in exacting conditions. Not only have the unique opportunities for innovation that MotoE™ offers seen Michelin increase the proportion of renewable and recycled raw materials that its tyres for the championship contain, but they are also speeding up the emergence of specific solutions for tomorrow's electric motorcycles and scooters.

Michelin sees MotoE™ as a means to accelerate innovation as it prepares for tomorrow's world of two-wheel mobility, with powerful analysis and smart data at the heart of its development processes.

A NEW DESIGN FOR THE REAR TIRE

This unique design features a head-turning look. Inspired by Michelin's VISION Concept, its ephemeral, velvet-effect Race to Vision motif vanishes once racing begins. VISION is the fruit of the sustainable development model conceived to contribute to Michelin's plan for 2050 and beyond.

RENEWABLE AND RECYCLED RAW MATERIALS



The MICHELIN MotoE range of tires contains 49 and 53 percent renewable and recycled materials front and rear respectively, compared with 34 and 52 percent in 2023.

- In the case that Q1 and Q2 sessions are both declared wet by the Race Director, the extra tires allocated will be rain tires.
- In the case that Q1 and Q2 sessions are declared as different weather conditions then no extra tire will be allocated.

Q1: the slowest 10 riders from the combined results of FP1 and FP2.

Q2: the fastest 8 riders from the combined results of FP1 and FP2 plus the fastest 2 riders from Q1.

RACE

Riders will complete one sighting lap before taking their position on the grid. There is no warm up lap, once the grid preparations have finished, the red light will go out and the race starts. Tire warmers may be used on the grid. Charging of the battery on the grid is permitted.
