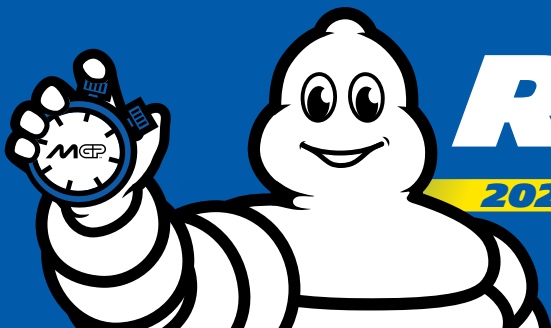

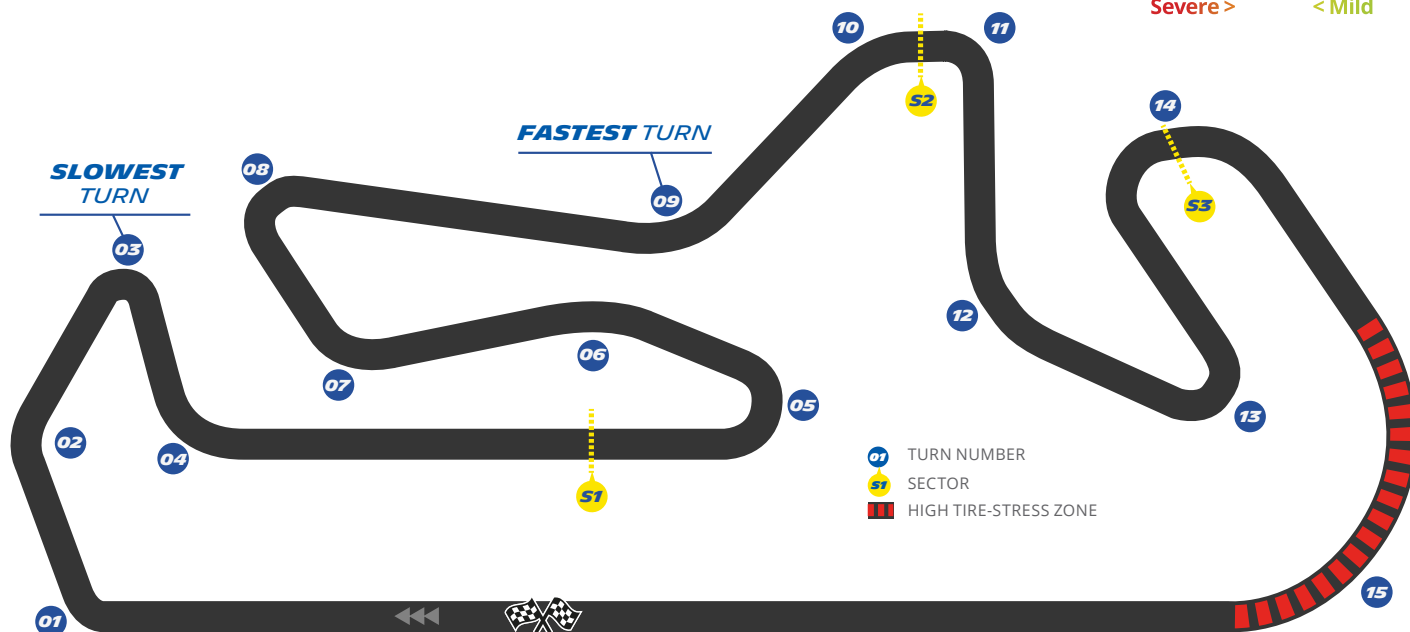

We come to Portimão with great confidence and high motivation. It is the penultimate round of the season, just before the Valencia finale and, even if the 2025 titles have already been decided, our focus remains absolute.

Portimão is a spectacular, demanding circuit, highly appreciated by riders, but it poses a real technical challenge for tires. It has everything: heavy downhill braking, fast flowing corners, blind acceleration zones, and sections where traction is critical. You need a tire that can do everything and do it consistently, without compromise.

Last year, the allocation we proposed fulfilled its mission perfectly, both in the Tissot Sprint and in the long race. Riders appreciated the confidence offered in the most critical phases, as well as the tire's consistent behaviour from the first to the last lap. We therefore chose to carry over exactly the same tire combination for 2025. Even though the race takes place in autumn this time, our analysis indicates conditions should remain very close to those seen in spring.

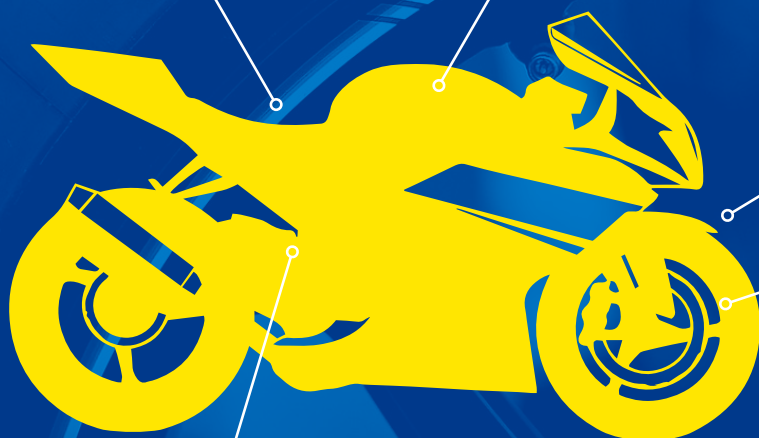

In the case that any 3 of the 5 sessions, being P1, P2, Free Practice, one Qualifying session, and the Sprint (always excluding warm-up), are declared wet, one more set of rain tires will be allocated to every rider, and the allocation automatically becomes: 7 Front rain tires, and 8 Rear rain tires.

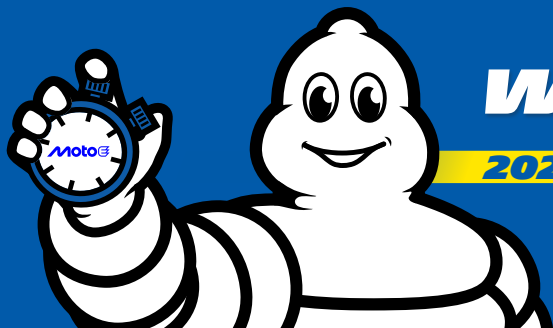

2025 FIM MotoE™



Michelin has been the sole tire supplier for the MotoE™ World Championship since its inception in 2019. It offers a unique environment for innovation, helping the Group speed up the integration of renewable or recycled materials in its tires and expand its knowledge of electric mobility — ultimately supporting faster development of its commercial product lines.

This year, Michelin's development teams achieved a historic milestone with **MotoE™ tires incorporating an average of 57% renewable or recycled materials** (58% front, 56% rear).

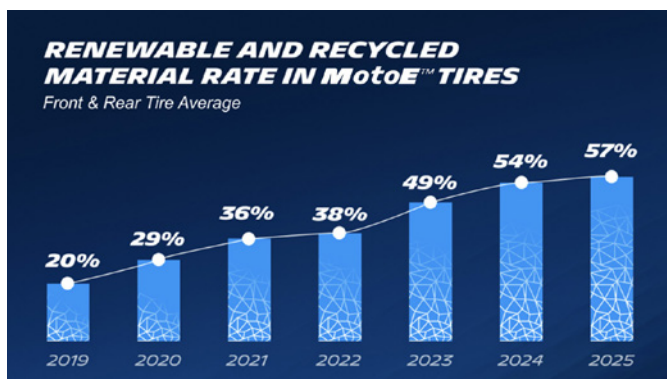
The MotoE™ tires feature a broad spectrum of **renewable and recycled materials**, including natural rubber from hevea tree sap, recycled carbon black from end-of-life tires (via pyrolysis by partner company Enviro), limonene resin from orange and lemon peels, rayon from wood cellulose, sunflower oil, recycled steel from scrap metal (via electric arc furnace by partner Global Steel Wire).

In 2025, Michelin integrates 57% renewable and recycled materials into its MotoE™ tires — while improving performance without increasing environment impact

MotoE™ Tires with a New Look Reflecting the Group's Ambition: The All-Sustainable Tire

After the rear tire in 2024, both the front and rear tires now feature the special livery, which has been slightly revised this year to extend over the sidewalls. This unique design, called Race to Vision, is directly inspired by the VISION Concept — a symbol of Michelin's sustainable tire development model looking ahead to 2050.

This design is reserved for tires that exceed 50% renewable and recycled content.

- Riders who participate in both Q1 and Q2 qualifying sessions (maximum 2 riders) will be allocated one extra rear slick tire after Q2 (therefore, if taken, a maximum of 6 rear new slick tires).
- In the case that Q1 and Q2 sessions are both declared wet by the Race Director, the extra tires allocated will be rain tires.
- In the case that Q1 and Q2 sessions are declared as different weather conditions then no extra tire will be allocated.

FREE PRACTICE

Two practice sessions (15 minutes) on Friday.

QUALIFYING PRACTICE

Q1: the slowest 10 riders from the combined results of practice.

Q2: the fastest 8 riders from the combined results of practice plus the fastest 2 riders from Q1.

RACE

Riders will complete one sighting lap before taking their position on the grid. There is no warm up lap, once the grid preparations have finished, the red light will go out and the race starts. Tire warmers may be used on the grid. Charging of the battery on the grid is permitted.
