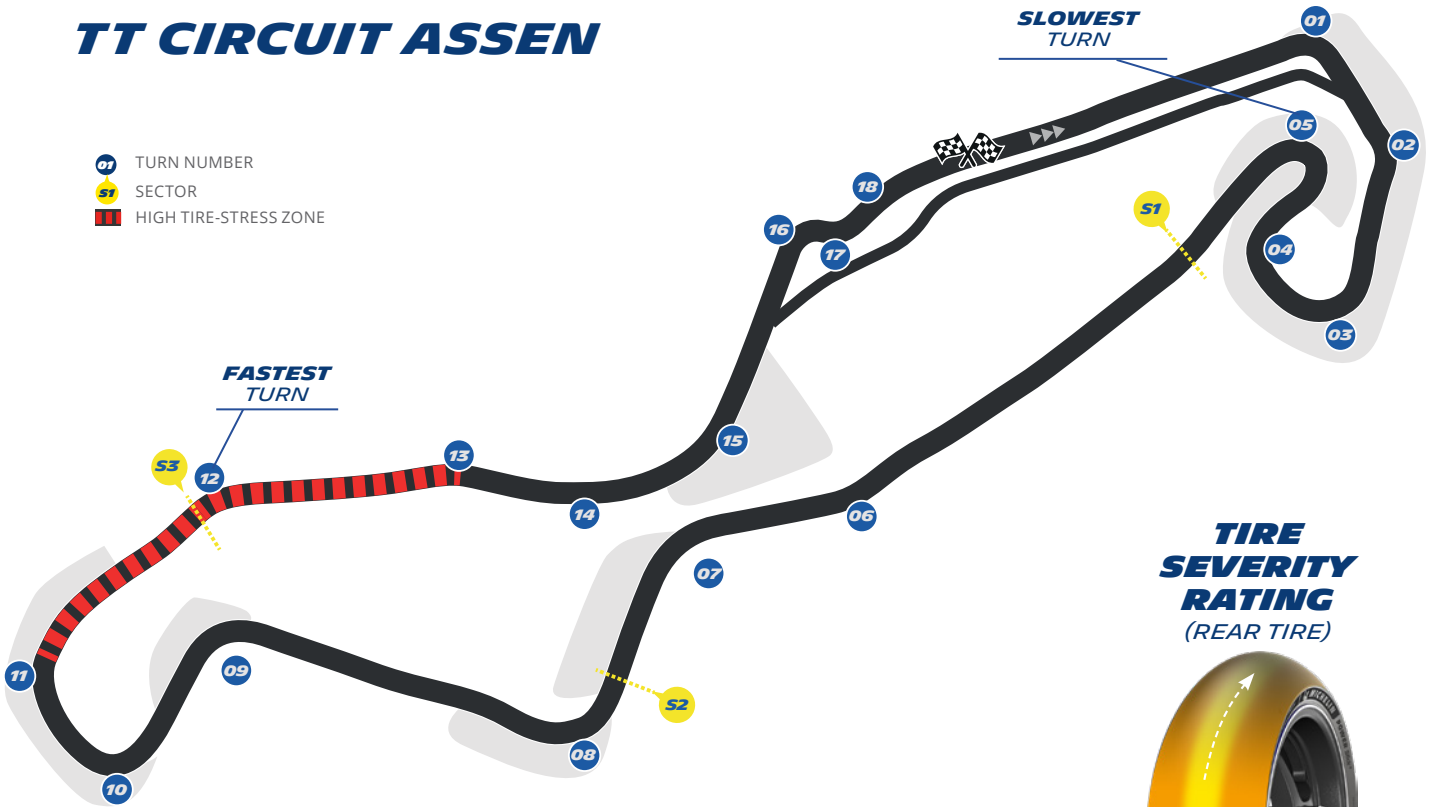

Assen is typically one of those circuits where the weather can turn things on their head in the space of a few minutes. Wind, cool temperatures or the onset of a downpour can very quickly alter track conditions and grip levels. The lessons learnt here in 2025 provide a solid foundation for preparing for this year's event and enable us to approach the various scenarios with confidence.

As the circuit layout is particularly fluid, the braking zones are less demanding than at other circuits on the calendar. On the other hand, the rear tire is put under considerable strain by repeated acceleration and long periods spent on edge. The moderate abrasiveness of the tarmac helps to limit wear, but the high average speeds and rapid changes of direction require close monitoring of tire temperature fluctuations.

The solutions used last season delivered a satisfactory level of performance and consistency in both the Sprint and the Grand Prix. For 2026, we have therefore built on the same technical fundamentals, which is a positive factor ahead of this new round where the theoretical set-ups are already known to everyone.

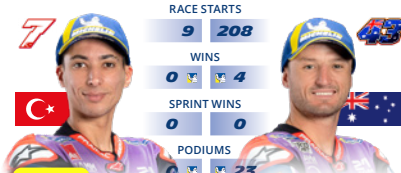

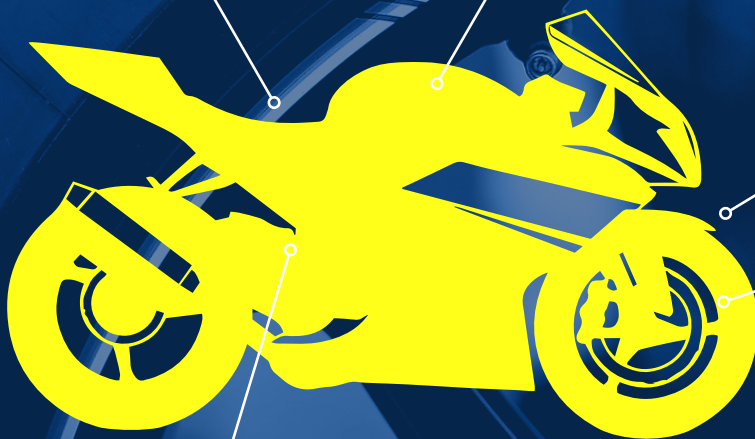

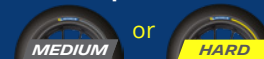
