

Sepang is a circuit we know very well, as we come here every year for both official and private testing. It's a demanding and complete track that combines fast corners, heavy braking zones and two long straights. Tires are constantly under stress—both front and rear—and the high temperatures make thermal management crucial.

Grip levels are generally good, both in dry and wet conditions, but the asphalt is abrasive and tire wear can be significant over race distance. That's why we have refined our allocation for 2025: at the front, we've kept the tires that performed very well last year while adding a new reinforced Hard specification that brings more

stability under braking and extra support for the most powerful bikes.

At the rear, we return to two standard carcasses, introducing a new Medium with stiffer compounds that performs particularly well in high temperatures. Our goal remains unchanged: to ensure consistent performance over race distance, full versatility between dry and wet conditions, and to allow our partners to make the most of their machines whatever the track configuration.
