

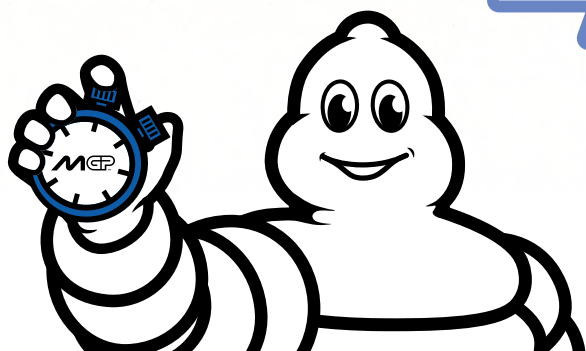

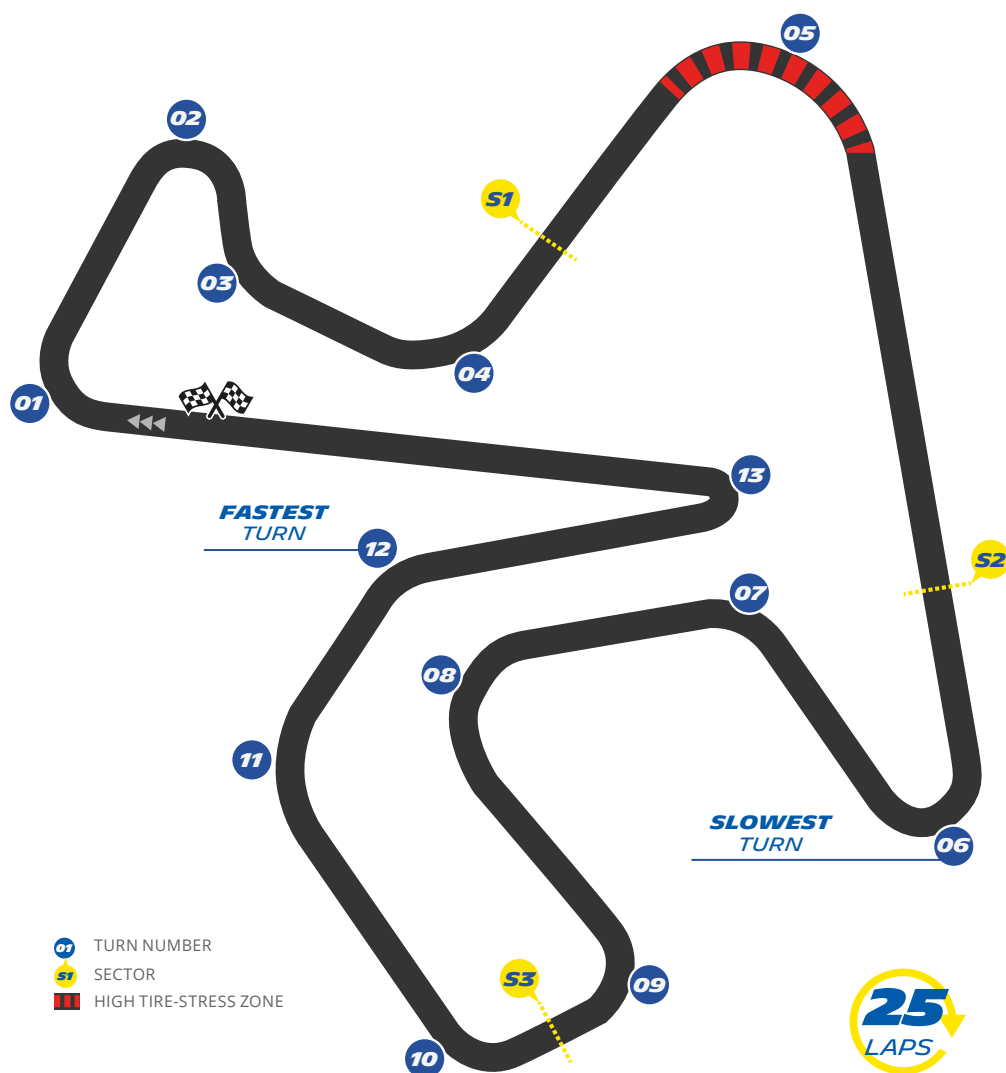

The teams and we ourselves are very happy to return to Jerez for the first race of the European calendar. This round promises to be particularly revealing of everyone's true level. The circuit is well known to the teams, who regularly organize private or official tests there with our support. Furthermore, our annual presence allows us to accumulate a significant amount of data, facilitating the selection of a tire package finely tailored to our partners' needs. We are also looking forward to seeing the fans in Jerez again, who are always out in force in Andalusia for a race with very specific, un characteristics. The track isn't particularly demanding in terms of wear, and top speeds are moderate, but it places continuous stress on our tires, with no real recovery phase, both at the front and the rear. Drawing on our knowledge of the circuit, we have decided to use the same compounds as in 2025, while omitting the Hard compound for the front, which was not used in the previous edition.

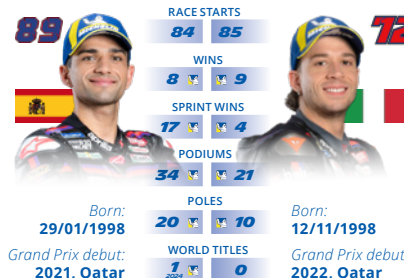

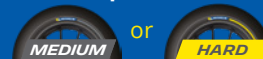

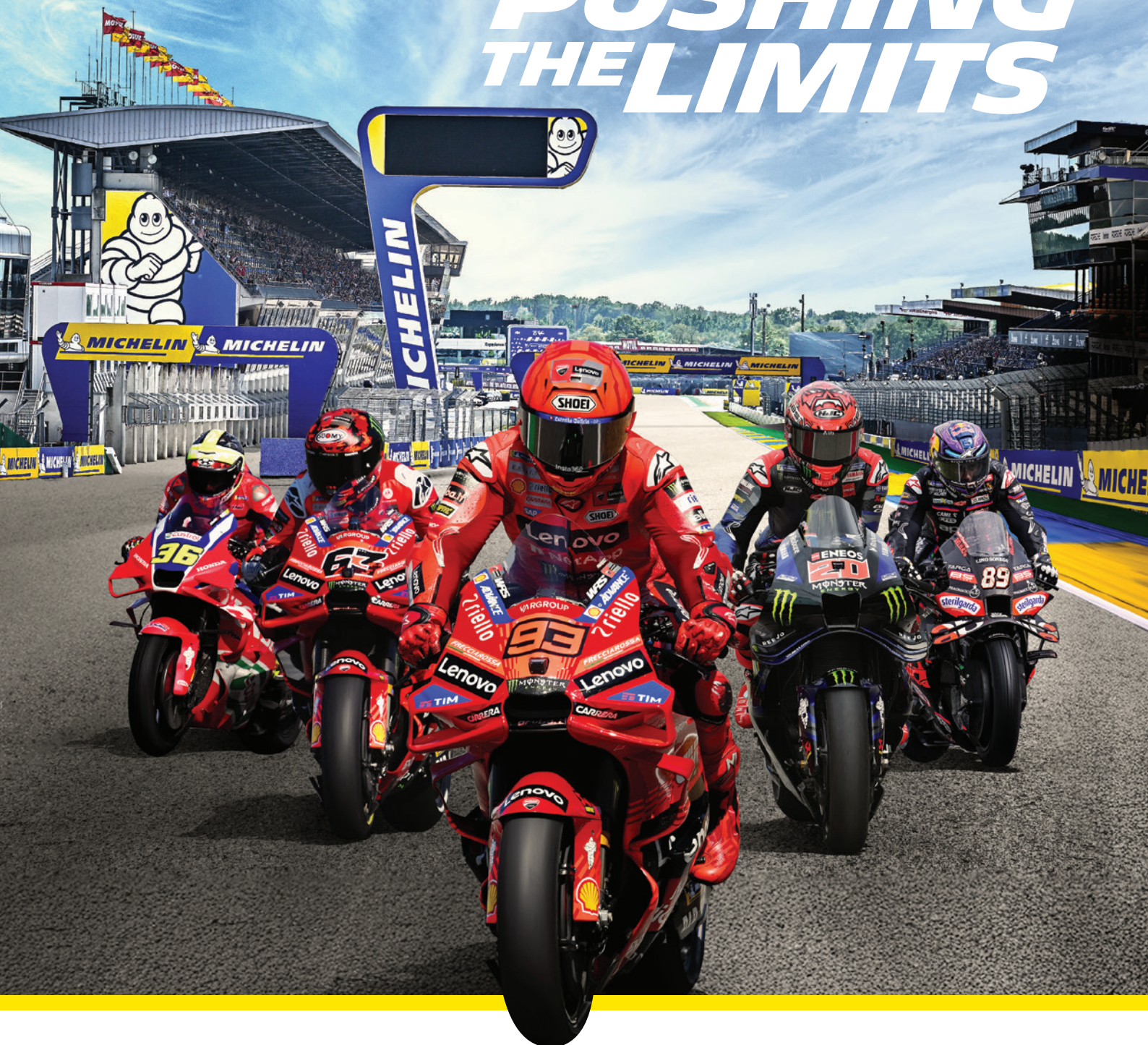
